Social Responsibility:

Simply Good Form is a socially-focused business and is committed to sustainable and consistent outreach supporting the LGBTQ2+ community.

Founder/CEO, Cynthia Sweeney volunteers as Chapter Lead for Pflag Halifax and is Vice Chair on the Board of PRIDE Lunenburg. She co-facilitates two monthly support groups for parents and caregivers of trans and gender expansive children.

Simply Good Form has produced free educational programming, lesson plans and support materials, which it provides to schools across Nova Scotia and families and individuals needing support.

In 2019, Simply Good Form created the first annual Inclusive Schools Read NS event which is now in its 5th cycle.

Simply Good Form produces the volunteer-led podcast, Hey, Cis! Which is co-hosted by Isaac Cook and Cynthia Sweeney.

In 2021 and 2022, 100% of the proceeds from the publishing of the inclusive children's story, The Pink Balloon, supports the hiring and operations of Simply Good Form.

Health and Safety:

In 2020, SGF moved to a virtual model for delivering their top-quality programming. We have a work-from-home option for team members based on their preference, rapid testing on-site and implemented thorough disinfecting of work stations and onsite 'everyone' washroom.
